# NATURE CAMP

This unique camp provides a "hands-on" approach to nature. Small groups of campers have a chance to interact with animals and discover nature.

#### **NATURE CAMP**

Your child is an aspiring explorer? Don't hesitate: the Ecomuseum Zoo's Nature Camp is a week of unforgettable adventures with Québec's wild flora and fauna.

Every year, new fun and enriching activities await participants. The activities include:

- Learning how to ensure the well-being of the animals in our care.
- Preparing enrichments for different animals like the Black Bear, the foxes, and even the turtles.
- · Experiencing many other surprises!

A child may be registered for only one week of camp per summer.

# NATURE CAMP «À LA CARTE»

The Nature Camp «À la carte» allows your child to participate in one, three, or even eight days of camp if you wish!

The  $\stackrel{.}{A}$  la carte» option is offered June 23 to 27\* and August 25 to 27, as soon as classes end and right before the start of the school year! A great way to start the summer, and to end it on a high.

A child may be registered to one or more days of the «À la carte» day camp, in addition to participating in one week of regular Nature Camp.

\*From June 23 to 27, the regular Nature Camp week is also offered.

#### CAMP 6 TO 7 YEARS OLD

This camp is intended for children who will be in Grade 1 or 2 of the 2025-2026 school year. The required age is set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2025. The participant's date of birth must be between October 1<sup>st</sup> 2017 and September 30<sup>th</sup> 2019. No exceptions will be made without proof of school derogation.

#### CAMP 8 TO 9 YEARS OLD

This camp is intended for children who will be in Grade 3 or 4 of the 2025-2026 school year. The required age is set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2025. The participant's date of birth must be between October 1<sup>st</sup> 2015 and September 30<sup>th</sup> 2017. No exceptions will be made without proof of school derogation.

## **CAMP 10 TO 12 YEARS OLD**

This camp is intended for children who will be in Grade 5, 6 or 7 of the 2025-2026 school year. The required age is set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2025. The participant's date of birth must be between October 1<sup>st</sup> 2012 and September 30<sup>th</sup> 2015. No exceptions will be made without proof of school derogation.

## JUNE 24TH AND JULY 1ST

We are open on the public holidays of June 24<sup>th</sup> and July 1<sup>st</sup>! Our counselors and assistant counselors look forward to spending an exciting day with your children!

#### **REGISTRATION PERIOD**

Wednesday, February  $19^{th}$  at 10 A.M. to Sunday, March 9 at 10 A.M.: Priority registration for children members (ages 6 to 12) - The registration link will be sent by e-mail.

Please ensure that your child's Ecomuseum Zoo membership is valid on the day of registration. A validity check will be made.

Starting Monday, March 10 at 10 A.M.: Registration for all - Directly on the Ecomuseum Zoo's website.

# NATURE CAMP «À LA CARTE» REGISTRATION DETAILS

## **REGISTRATION PERIOD**

Wednesday, February  $19^{th}$  at 10 A.M. to Sunday, March 9 at 10 A.M.: Priority registration for children members (ages 6 to 12) - The registration link will by sent be e-mail.

Please ensure that your child's Ecomuseum Zoo membership is valid on the day of registration. A validity check will be made.

Starting Monday, March 10 at 10 A.M.: Registration for all - Directly on the Ecomuseum Zoo's website.

A child may be registered for several days of «À la carte» Nature camp, in addition to one regular week of Nature Camp.

Each day must be reserved individually

#### **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

Each camp has a set age requirement. To participate, children must be of the age generally required for the class (grades 1 to 6). Limit dates are set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2025.

Children must be fluent in the language of the camp session for which they are registering.

A child may be registered for only one week of Nature Camp per summer, in addition to «À la carte» Nature Camp.

#### **HOW TO REGISTER**

To register one or more children for a session, you must complete one online registration form per child. You must pay online by credit card (Visa or MasterCard).

Registration can take time and there is a high demand. We advise you to prepare all the elements in advance and to organise yourself accordingly if you have multiple children who would like to register to the same camp week.

A \$50 administration fee will be charged to transfer a child's registration from one session to another, subject to availability, and cannot be guaranteed.

Registration is not transferable.

For members' priority registration, the child's membership (6 to 12 years old) must be valid on the day of booking.

#### **METHODS OF PAYMENT**

Payment must be made in full upon registration.

A transaction receipt will be issued to you at registration at no charge.

#### **REFUND POLICY**

If, for any reason, the Ecomuseum Zoo must cancel a session, a full refund will be given.

If your child is registered and cannot attend camp, you will receive a refund of 90% of the total registration fee if you cancel on or before April 30th, 2025.

From May 1st, 2025, no refund will be granted unless canceled due to illness (upon presentation of a medical certificate).

We reserve the right to expel a child from the camp without reimbursement if the code of conduct is not respected by the child or the parent.

#### **SANITARY MEASURES**

The safety of camp participants, our volunteers, our staff and the animals in our care is our priority.

The Ecomuseum Zoo vows to put in place all the sanitary measures required by Public Health at the time of the camp and to ensure that everyone complies with them at all times.

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
