

# WORKSHOP: WILDLIFE DETECTIVES: ANIMAL TRACKS

#### CAPACITY & PRICING

**1** At the Zoo with guided tour (1h30):  
Minimum of 20\*\* and maximum of 30 students per presentation. Maximum of 4 presentations per day. Student = \$19.50  
Additional\* accompanying adult = \$28.50  
\*We offer one free accompanying adult for every 10 paying students.

**2** Our zoologists visit your classrooms:  
Minimum of 25\*\* and maximum of 30 students per presentation. Minimum of 2 and maximum of 4 presentations per trip.  
Student = \$10.50  
Transportation fee = \$0.89/km with minimum fee of \$60.00  
(maximum 85 km in one direction).  
+ Waiting time totaling more than 60 minutes between presentations = \$60.00/hour.
