CAPACITY & PRICING

- 1 At the Zoo with guided tour (1h30):
Minimum of 20** and maximum of 30 students per presentation. Maximum of 4 presentations per day.
Student = \$19.50
Additional* accompanying adult = \$28.50
*We offer one free accompanying adult for every 10 paying students.
- 2 Our zoologists visit your classrooms:
Minimum of 25** and maximum of 30 students per presentation. Minimum of 2 and maximum of 4 presentations per trip.
Student = \$10.50
Transportation fee = \$0.89/km with minimum fee of \$60.00
(maximum 85 km in one direction).
+ Waiting time totaling more than 60 minutes between presentations = \$60.00/hour.
- 3 Virtually:
Minimum of 25** participants per presentation.
Student = \$7.25
