Presentations: (60 mins)

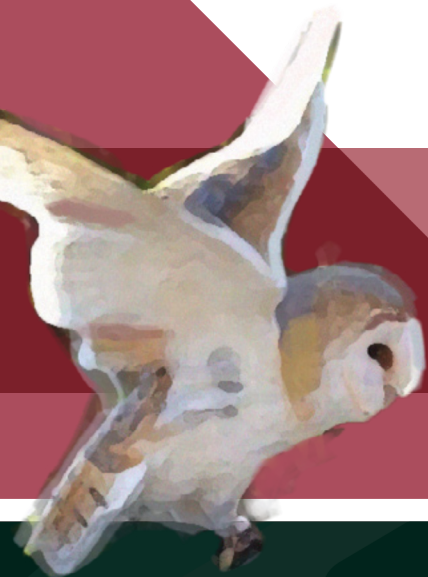
- The ecosystems of Quebec

WORKSHOP: OWL PELLET DISSECTION
