## NATURE CAMP

Every year, new fun and enriching activities await participants. The activities include:

## NATURE CAMP « À LA CARTE »

The Nature Camp « À la carte » is offered before the start of the school year to allow your child to extend their summer with the frenzy of summer camp!

The «À la carte» option is offered August 24, 25, and 26. A great way to end the summer!

A child may be registered to one or more days of the « À la carte » day camp, in addition to participating in one week of regular Nature Camp.

## JUNE 24<sup>TH</sup> AND JULY 1<sup>ST</sup>

We are open on the public holidays of June 24<sup>th</sup> and July 1<sup>st</sup>! Our counselors and assistant counselors look forward to spending an exciting day with your children!

## BAT CAMP (6-7 YEARS OLD)

This camp is intended for children who will be in Grade 1 or 2 of the 2026-2027 school year. The required age is set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2026. The participant's date of birth must be between October 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 and September 30<sup>th</sup> 2020. No exceptions will be made without proof of school derogation.

## SQUIRREL CAMP (8-9 YEARS OLD)

This camp is intended for children who will be in Grade 3 or 4 of the 2026-2027 school year. The required age is set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2026. The participant's date of birth must be between October 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 and September 30<sup>th</sup> 2018. No exceptions will be made without proof of school derogation.

## GROUNDHOG CAMP (10-12 YEARS OLD)

This camp is intended for children who will be in Grade 5, 6 or 7 of the 2026-2027 school year. The required age is set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2026. The participant's date of birth must be between October 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 and September 30<sup>th</sup> 2016. No exceptions will be made without proof of school derogation.

## HERON CAMP (6-12 YEARS OLD)

This camp is intended for children who will be in Grade 1 through 7 of the 2026-2027 school year. The required age is set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2026. The participant's date of birth must be between October 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 and September 30<sup>th</sup> 2020. No exceptions will be made without proof of school derogation.

Starting Wednesday , February 18 at 10 A.M.: Registration for all - Directly on the Ecomuseum Zoo's website.

## NATURE CAMP « À LA CARTE » REGISTRATION DETAILS

### REGISTRATION PERIOD

Tuesday, February 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10 A.M. to Sunday, February 15 at 10 P.M.: Priority registration for children members (ages 6 to 12) - The registration link will be sent by e-mail.

Please ensure that your child's Ecomuseum Zoo membership is valid on the day of registration. A validity check will be made.

Starting Wednesday , February 18 at 10 A.M.: Registration for all - Directly on the Ecomuseum Zoo's website.

**A child may be registered for several days of « À la carte » Nature Camp, in addition to one regular week of Nature Camp.**

### ADMISSION CRITERIA

Each camp has a set age requirement. To participate, children must be of the age generally required for the class (grades 1 to 6). Limit dates are set to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2026.

Children must be fluent in the language of the camp session for which they are registering.

A child may be registered for only one week of Nature Camp per summer, in addition to the « À la carte » Nature Camp days.

### HOW TO REGISTER

To register one or more children for a session, you must complete one online registration form per child. You must pay online by credit card (Visa or MasterCard).

Registration can take time and there is a high demand. We advise you to prepare all the elements in advance and to organise yourself accordingly if you have multiple children who would like to register to the same camp week.

A \$50 administration fee will be charged to transfer a child's registration from one session to another, subject to availability, and cannot be guaranteed.

Registration is not transferable from one child to another.

For members' priority registration, the child's membership (6 to 12 years old) must be valid on the day of booking.

### METHODS OF PAYMENT

Payment must be made in full upon registration.

A transaction receipt will be issued to you at registration at no charge.

### GROUP

Bat, Squirrel, and Heron groups will be subdivided in two or three groups each. During registration, you may indicate any preferences in the section "Additional Information" to keep your child with certain participants (friends, siblings, etc.), but we cannot guarantee availability.

### REFUND POLICY

If, for any reason, the Ecomuseum Zoo must cancel a session, a full refund will be given.

If your child is registered and cannot attend camp, you will receive a refund of 90% of the total registration fee if you cancel on or before April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

From May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026, no refund will be granted unless canceled due to illness (upon presentation of a medical certificate).

We reserve the right to expel a child from the camp without reimbursement if the code of conduct is not respected by the child or the parent.
